Cooking Classes:

Brazil is a country with a very rich and diverse culture and so is our food. With this cooking class the student will not only learn how to prepare delicious dishes will have the opportunity to taste them too.

Dance Instruction:

Brazil is a country with many rhythms and many celebrations. Reflecting on this fact, we chose one day each week to offer dance classes to our students. Capoeira Instruction:

Capoeira is one of the most important cultural expressions in Brazil. Practiced here since the time of slavery, it is an expression of the resistance and beauty of Black culture in this country. In order to promote the most sincere cultural encounter between our students and the culture of Brazil, we hold capoeira classes once a week in our school with a special instructor. Percussion Instruction:

Brazil has a great musical diversity. Pernambuco is one of the states that have a strong musical culture with many local rhythms as frevo, maracatu, forró, mangubeat, the sieve and the caboclinho. In our class the student can have an overview of these rhythms and knowing the great musicality of Brazilian music.

Brazilian Cinema Sessions:

Brazilian cinema has grown significantly in recent years. Noting this trend, we have organized a weekly session in our school for the purpose of screening Brazilian films. This is a class accompanied by an instructor, and exists as an additional opportunity for students to augment their vocabulary, and to learn slang and idiomatic expressions.

Seminar on Brazilian Culture:

Brazil has a distinct and varied culture due to its emergence from diverse cultural experiences, that when mixed, resulted in the creation of a new Brazilian culture. Our seminar on Brazilian culture reflects this fact. All students meet together in one room to participate in a special course dedicated to themes of Brazilian culture, such as, history, music, geography, sports, cinema, cuisine and more. This course meets once a week in our mini auditorium, where we have plenty of space and equipment so that the experience is dynamic and comfortable for all.
